

Manager's Report Completed for the April 8, 2023 Board Meeting

1) Business Cloud Storage

A Dropbox file structure for Errol by the Sea has been created. Dropbox is an online file sharing site that will make it possible for all Board Members to have access to important documents of the business. 2) Upcoming Maintenance Projects

Big projects that will be happening this month:

- Stairwells will be painted.
- A/C lines will be cleaned out to be ready for summer.
- The pool deck windscreen will be coming down on April 26th and the pool heater will be turned off.
- 3) A/C Inspections

We have completed all warranty checklist items and performed the a/c condenser unit inspections. All owners who had rusted/bad condensers have been contacted. New A/C brackets have been all on condensers, with just a few units that were too rusted for us to be able to drill into. We will be doing these inspections quarterly. A/C conduits being worked on is the last step. Letters will be going out to owners who are needing conduit work.
